Georgia is located in the Caucasus region, on the eastern coast of the Black Sea, between Europe and Asia. Most surrogacy journeys take place in Tbilisi, the capital city.

Welcome to Georgia: A Safe, Historic, and Beautiful Destination for Your Surrogacy Journey

Georgia is a beautiful and welcoming country located in the **Caucasus region**, where Eastern Europe meets Western Asia. It sits on the eastern side of the Black Sea and is bordered by Russia, Turkey, Armenia, and Azerbaijan. Its capital city, **Tbilisi**, has been Georgia's cultural, political, and economic center for about **15 centuries**, and historic Old Tbilisi is known for its cobblestone streets, colorful balconies, ancient churches, sulfur baths, and warm hospitality. Georgia's official tourism site describes Tbilisi as one of Europe's oldest capitals and highlights Old Tbilisi, its famous sulfur baths, Metekhi Temple, and Mtatsminda views as key visitor attractions.

Why Intended Parents Can Feel Comfortable Traveling to Georgia



For intended parents, traveling abroad for surrogacy can feel emotional and unfamiliar. Georgia helps make the journey feel more manageable because it offers a combination of **supportive surrogacy laws, experienced fertility providers, international travel access, modern hotels, and U.S. Embassy support in Tbilisi.**

Georgia is also considered a generally safe travel destination for U.S. citizens when normal precautions are followed. The U.S. Department of State currently lists Georgia as **Level 1: Exercise Normal Precautions**, while advising travelers not to visit the Russian-occupied regions of **South Ossetia and Abkhazia** because of crime, civil unrest, and landmine risks. Intended parents traveling for surrogacy normally stay in Tbilisi and do not need to visit those restricted regions. ([Travel State Gov](#))

For extra peace of mind, U.S. intended parents should enroll in the **Smart Traveler Enrollment Program, STEP**, before travel. This allows the U.S. Embassy to send alerts and makes it easier to contact travelers in an emergency. The State Department also recommends travel insurance that includes medical, evacuation, and trip-cancellation coverage. ([Travel State Gov](#))

Legal Peace of Mind for Intended Parents

Georgia has long been known as one of the more legally structured international surrogacy destinations for eligible intended parents. Under Georgia’s surrogacy framework, gestational surrogacy is permitted when required written consent and documentation are in place. The key reassurance for intended parents is that the surrogate is not treated as the legal mother of the child; the intended parents are recognized through the required documentation and birth registration process.

For U.S. parents, the baby’s U.S. citizenship and passport process is handled through the U.S. Embassy in Tbilisi. The U.S. Embassy has a dedicated surrogacy page and notes that intended parents must bring clear copies of all supporting documents for each child when applying. (ge.usembassy.gov) The U.S. Department of State explains that citizenship for a child born abroad through assisted reproductive technology or surrogacy is determined when parents apply for the child’s **Consular Report of Birth Abroad, CRBA, or U.S. passport**, and the embassy may request evidence such as parental citizenship, physical presence in the U.S., and biological or legal parentage documentation. U.S. Embassy in Tbilisi

The U.S. Embassy is located in Tbilisi, which is reassuring for American intended parents who need help with citizenship documents, passport processing, or emergency support.

The State Department lists the embassy telephone as **+(995)(32) 227-7724** during business hours and **+(995)(32) 227-7000** for emergencies involving U.S. citizens. ([Travel State Gov](#))

Most intended parents stay in central Tbilisi, usually 25–40 minutes from the U.S. Embassy depending on traffic. The embassy is accessible by taxi or private driver.

Airport and Flights From the USA



The main airport for intended parents is **Tbilisi International Airport**, also known by the airport code **TBS**. It is the primary international airport serving Tbilisi and the surrounding region. Current airport route information shows international service through major connecting cities such as **Istanbul, Paris, Amsterdam, Dubai, Munich, Vienna, Doha, London, and Frankfurt**, among others. (tbilisiairport.com)

At this time, most U.S. travelers should expect **one-stop or two-stop flights** rather than nonstop flights from the United States to Tbilisi. Common routes include:

- **New York / JFK or Newark to Tbilisi** through Istanbul, Doha, Frankfurt, Paris, Amsterdam, or Munich
- **Washington, D.C. to Tbilisi** through Istanbul, Doha, Frankfurt, or European hubs
- **Chicago to Tbilisi** through Istanbul, Doha, Frankfurt, or Munich
- **Los Angeles / San Francisco to Tbilisi** through Istanbul, Doha, Dubai, or major European hubs
- **Miami to Tbilisi** through Istanbul, Doha, Paris, or other European connections

Typical total travel time from the U.S. is usually:

U.S. Departure City	Typical Route	Approximate Total Travel Time
New York / Newark	1 stop via Istanbul, Doha, Paris, Amsterdam, Frankfurt, or Munich	14–18 hours
Washington, D.C.	1 stop via Istanbul, Doha, or Europe	15–19 hours
Chicago	1 stop via Istanbul, Doha, or Europe	16–21 hours
Miami	1 stop via Istanbul, Doha, or Europe	16–22 hours
Los Angeles / San Francisco	1 stop via Istanbul, Doha, Dubai, or Europe	18–24 hours

Flight times vary by airline, layover, season, and connection city. Tbilisi has direct flights to many connecting hubs, including Istanbul at about **2 hours 35 minutes**, Doha at about **3 hours 15 minutes**, Frankfurt at about **4 hours 35 minutes**, Munich at about **4 hours 15 minutes**, Paris at about **5 hours 20 minutes**, Amsterdam at about **5 hours**, and London at about **5 hours 50 minutes**. Arrival in Tbilisi

After landing at Tbilisi International Airport, intended parents usually take a taxi, hotel car, or arranged private transfer to their hotel. Many central hotels are about **20–40 minutes from the airport**, depending on traffic. For example, Courtyard by Marriott Tbilisi lists Tbilisi International Airport as approximately **17 km** from the hotel. ([Marriott](#))

We recommend arranging airport pickup in advance so intended parents arrive calmly, especially after a long international flight. A private driver can meet you at arrivals, help with luggage, and take you directly to your hotel.

Comfortable Hotels in Tbilisi for Intended Parents



Tbilisi has many modern hotels suitable for international intended parents. Good choices usually include central location, English-speaking staff, reliable Wi-Fi, elevator access, airport transfer options, room service, and easy taxi access to clinics, hospitals, and the U.S. Embassy.

1. Courtyard by Marriott Tbilisi — Freedom Square

Located at **4 Freedom Square**, this is a convenient central option for intended parents who want to stay near Old Tbilisi, restaurants, pharmacies, shops, and sightseeing. The hotel lists amenities including Wi-Fi, restaurant, indoor pool, fitness center, business center, and airport shuttle service. ([Marriott](#))

2. Tbilisi Marriott Hotel — Rustaveli Avenue

A classic upscale hotel on Rustaveli Avenue, ideal for parents who prefer a traditional international hotel brand in the city center. It is close to museums, cafés, shopping, and cultural landmarks. ([Marriott](#))

3. The Biltmore Hotel Tbilisi

The Biltmore is a five-star hotel in a central location near arts and culture venues. The hotel describes itself as centrally located, close to landmarks including the Georgian National

Opera and Theatre, Rustaveli National Theatre, and the Abanotubani sulfur baths district. (thebiltmorehotels.com)

4. Radisson Blu Iveria Hotel, Tbilisi City Centre

A well-known central hotel at **First Republic Square**, with city views, restaurants, wellness facilities, and easy access to central Tbilisi. (silkhospitality.com)

5. Stamba Hotel

A stylish boutique hotel in the **Mtatsminda District** at **14 Kostava Street**, popular with travelers who enjoy design, culture, restaurants, and a more boutique experience. ([Stamba - სტამბა](#))

6. Pullman Tbilisi Axis Towers

A modern hotel in the Vake area at **37M Ilia Chavchavadze Avenue**, suitable for intended parents who prefer a newer international-style hotel in a quieter, upscale neighborhood. ([Pullman Tbilisi Hotel](#))

Suggested note:

For the baby's birth trip, many intended parents prefer a hotel with larger rooms, laundry access, room service, elevator access, nearby pharmacies, and space for baby supplies.

Tourist Things to See While in Tbilisi



Many intended parents find that spending a few calm days in Tbilisi before appointments helps them feel more comfortable. The city is historic, walkable in many central areas, and filled with warm cafés, restaurants, and family-friendly sightseeing.

Recommended places to visit:

Old Tbilisi — The historic heart of the city, with cobblestone streets, balconies, cafés, churches, and scenic views. Georgia’s tourism site describes Old Tbilisi as a must-see area with some of the city’s most iconic sites. ([Georgia Travel](#))

Abanotubani Sulfur Baths — Famous domed bathhouses fed by natural hot sulfur water. These baths are one of Tbilisi’s most recognizable attractions. ([Georgia Travel](#))

Narikala Fortress — A historic fortress overlooking the city and river. It offers beautiful views of Tbilisi.

Metekhi Church and Viewpoint — A scenic place overlooking Old Tbilisi and the Mtkvari River. Georgia’s tourism site highlights Metekhi Temple as one of the city’s memorable viewpoints. ([Georgia Travel](#))

Mtatsminda Park and Funicular — A family-friendly mountain park with cafés, views, and an easy funicular ride above the city. ([Georgia Travel](#))

Bridge of Peace and Rike Park — A modern pedestrian bridge and park area, good for a short walk and photos.

Holy Trinity Cathedral of Tbilisi, Sameba — One of the largest Orthodox cathedrals in the region and a peaceful place to visit.

Georgian National Museum and Rustaveli Avenue — Good for history, culture, shopping, and easy city walking.

Day trip to Mtskheta — A beautiful historic town near Tbilisi, often visited for churches, mountain views, and Georgian history.

Day trip to Kakheti wine region — Georgia is one of the world’s oldest wine-producing countries, and Kakheti offers scenic vineyards and countryside. This is best done before the baby arrives or during a non-medical waiting period.

Helpful Safety and Comfort Tips for Intended Parents

Before travel, intended parents should make digital and printed copies of passports, marriage documents if applicable, surrogacy contracts, clinic letters, embryo transfer

documentation, birth-related documents, insurance information, and embassy appointment confirmations. The U.S. Embassy’s surrogacy guidance specifically notes that applicants must bring clear copies of supporting documents for each child.

Parents should also bring basic baby supplies for the return trip, including newborn clothes, bottles, formula if needed, diapers, wipes, a baby blanket, and any pediatrician-recommended items. Many supplies are available in Tbilisi, but having essentials ready reduces stress after delivery.

For transportation, intended parents should use hotel cars, private drivers, or trusted taxi apps rather than walking late at night in unfamiliar areas. Central Tbilisi is comfortable for visitors, but parents should use the same common-sense precautions they would use in any international city.

1. Clear Legal Recognition of Intended Parents
